MON, 8/19, 2:51 AM	The security monitoring company for Glendale Chrysler Jeep Dodge, 10070 Manchester Road, reported observing a suspicious person on the parking lot. Officers contacted the 34-year-old Warrenton, Missouri man who stated he was just “window shopping” before heading home. He was advised to leave the area and complied.
