MON, 9/16, 2:18 AM	Officers investigated a vehicle alarm sounding in the 400 block of N. Sappington Road.
MON, 9/16, 6:55 PM	Officers provided security for the Board of Aldermen meeting.
TUE, 9/17, 7:00 AM	Officers investigated a complaint of illegally placed construction dumpsters in the 900 block of Brownell Avenue. The dumpsters were placed temporarily for a driveway and porch demolition project and were removed by the end of the day. There were no traffic concerns.
