MON, 12/16, 12:55 PM	Officers investigated a non-injury vehicle crash on Austin Place at Trevillian Avenue.
MON, 12/16, 1:25 PM	Officers assisted a stranded motorist on N. Sappington Road at Hawbrook Road.
