MON, 11/4, 9:12 AM	A resident of the 800 block of Victoria Place reported being the victim of Identity Theft. Unknown persons used his personal information to open three separate accounts and make fraudulent purchases with Verizon, Sephora and Best Buy. Police are investigating.
