MON, 10/14, 8:53 AM	A resident of the 800 block of E. Essex Avenue reported she was the victim of an Identity Theft. Unknown person(s) used her personal information to open a savings account in her name with Goldman Sachs. Investigation revealed there has been no activity on the account, and it was subsequently closed.
