MON, 5/12, 9:40 AM	Officers investigated a report of high grass at a residence in the unit block of Cambridge Court. Officers contacted the resident who advised her landscaper quit and she did not have anyone to cut her grass. A neighbor volunteered to assist with cutting the grass until she could make other arrangements.
