MON, 1/20, 6:44 AM	Officers responded to a report of a water main break on N. Sappington Road at W. Kirkham Avenue. Missouri American Water was notified and responded. Water company crews believed the water main break was actually a leaking valve and marked the area for future repairs. Frigid temperatures and additional water caused icing on N. Sappington Road, W. Kirkham Avenue and the 800 block of Alexandra Avenue. Public Works crews responded to heavily salt the area and break up the ice. On Wednesday, 1/22, Missouri American Water crews located a broken pipe which required major repairs and water shutoffs in the area. Classes at North Glendale School were cancelled on Thursday, January 23, 2025, due to no water service. The broken pipe was repaired, damage to the roadway was addressed and water service was restored as of 2:30 PM on Thursday, January 23, 2025. Classes resumed at North Glendale School as usual on Friday, January 24, 2025.
