MON, 11/17, 9:10 AM	A resident of the unit block of Trevillian Avenue reported finding a bicycle in her front yard. The resident stated she checked with her neighbors, and no one knew the owner. The resident stated she would leave the bicycle in its place in hopes that the owner would retrieve it. She was advised to contact police if no one claims the bicycle.
MON, 11/17, 6:56 PM	Officers investigated a non-injury vehicle crash on N. Berry Road at W. Kirkham Avenue.
