SAT, 1/31, 9:58 AM Officers were alerted by one of our license plate reader cameras to a "wanted" vehicle out of St. Louis City for Felony Leaving the Scene of an Accident. The vehicle was southbound on N. Sappington Road from Manchester Road. An officer observed the vehicle as it passed him while he was traveling northbound. He turned around and followed the vehicle southbound while he attempted to verify the wanted information with Dispatch. The vehicle turned east onto Beverly Avenue in what appeared to be an attempt to evade the officer but was stopped by the Dead End. The vehicle turned around and proceeded west on Beverly Avenue, ran the stop sign and was struck by a northbound vehicle. The "wanted" vehicle spun out, jumped the curb and came to a stop in the front yard of a residence in the 300 block of N. Sappington Road. The officer stopped and ordered the occupants out of the vehicle. Both occupants were armed and fled the scene on foot. Warson Woods, Kirkwood and Webster Groves officers responded to assist in the search for the two suspects. Officers were able to locate the suspects and held them at gunpoint until assisting officers arrived to assist in the arrest. A loaded Glock pistol was found on the driver's seat, which had been modified to be fully automatic

when fired. A second firearm, a fully loaded handheld semi-automatic rifle was recovered during the foot pursuit. The St. Louis County Prosecuting Attorney's Office charged the suspects as follows: (Driver) Lebryan Tyrik Jones, 18, of the 10500 block of Repose Drive, Bellefontaine Neighbors, Mo., with one count each Leaving the Scene of an Accident, Aggravated Fleeing a Lawful Stop/Detention and Unlawful Possession of an Altered Firearm. Bond was set at \$150,000 cash only. The passenger, Johnathan Terrell Blackmon, 20, of the 2200 block of Oriole Drive, Florissant, Mo., was charged with one count of Resisting Felony Arrest. Bond was set at \$150,000 cash only. Both suspects remain in custody at the St. Louis County Justice Center in Clayton, Missouri.
