



DUMPSTER PERMIT REGULATIONS

A dumpster permit is required for placing a dumpster on private property or the public street. Placement of a dumpster on a public street is only permitted with the approval of the Chief of Police and is subject to the following conditions:

1. **Proximity to Curb:** The dumpster must be positioned no more than six inches (6") from the curb (measured from the inside corner of the dumpster) and must allow for the safe passage of vehicles at all times.
2. **Visibility and Safety:** The dumpster must be equipped with functioning flashing lights at each outer corner. Alternatively, light-equipped barricades may be used to ensure visibility to motorists, particularly at night.
3. **Surface Protection:** Two-inch (2") thick lumber must be placed beneath all wheel loads. The minimum width of the lumber must match the width of the wheels.
4. **Pavement and Curbing:** The applicant is responsible for repairing any damage to pavement or curbing caused by the placement, use, or removal of the dumpster. All repairs must meet the satisfaction of the City.
5. **Condition:** The dumpster shall be used to contain only building construction waste materials and not allowed to become foul smelling or collect rainwater and shall be dumped/removed promptly when full so it does not become a nuisance.
6. **Permit Duration:** Dumpster permits are valid for a maximum of 60 days and may be renewed in 30-day increments upon approval by the Police Chief or Building Commissioner.
