MON, 8/24, 5:30 AM	A resident of the unit block of Cambridge Court reported a possible electrical transformer issue in the area as 6 homes were without power. Power was restored by 6:30 AM.
MON, 8/24, 12:38 PM	Officers assisted the Fire Department with an EMS Call in the unit block of Country Club Terrace.

The cyclist, a 56-year-old Warson Woods woman, was conveyed to a local hospital where she died as a result of her injuries. Witnesses at the scene stated the cyclist entered the intersection southbound against a steady red electric signal and was struck by the eastbound vehicle. Their statements were corroborated by a nearby business' surveillance camera. Our thoughts and prayers are with all involved in this tragic incident.
